

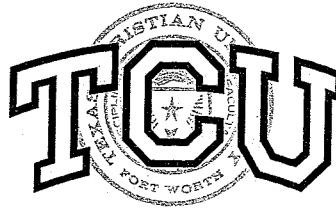

1 **“A Bill to Support the Finance Committee in its Fundraising Efforts to Help the**
2 **Victims of the Recent Hurricanes”**

3 Whereas: The TCU mission statement calls for TCU to educate individuals to act as
4 ethical leaders in a global society, and

5 Whereas: SGA’s mission is to encompass the spirit of the TCU community through
6 service, and

7 Whereas: There are many millions of people affected by Hurricanes Katrina, and Rita,
8 many of which are students who go to this school, and

9 Whereas: The House of Representatives has prescribed a short term answer to a long term
10 problem by allocating \$10,000 to a hurricane relief fund, the Hurricane
11 Emergency Relief Fund, and

12 Whereas: The House of Representative has passed a resolution to support the collection
13 of monies in helping hurricane victims, and

14 Whereas: It takes money to run a successful fundraising campaign, therefore

15 Let it be enacted by the House of Student Representatives at Texas Christian University:

16 (1) A sum of \$1,000 shall be allocated to the Finance committee in order that they
17 may be able to run a large fundraising campaign to collect monies with which to
18 add to the Hurricane Emergency Relief Fund.

19 (2) All funds collected that are not distributed by the time the Hurricane Emergency
20 Relief Fund expires on December 31, 2005 shall be given to a charity chosen by
21 the Student House of Representatives.

22 (3) All allocated funds, unused by the Finance committee in raising funds for the
23 Hurricane Emergency Relief Fund, shall be returned when the Hurricane
24 Emergency Relief Fund expires on December 31, 2005
